Dear Timberline Figure Skating Members,

This letter is outlining the policy for “Testing/Competition Permission” for those skaters who are competing in competitions and testing on the United States Figure Skating Test Track. This letter **does not** affect any Learn to Skate USA tests that are conducted at the end of each basic skills program.

Timberline members who plan to compete (if the hosting club requires permission) or participate in a USFSA test session will need to obtain a signature from a designated board member (a list has been provided below for your convenience). **No forged or photocopied signatures will be allowed.** Timberline will be checking test sessions/competitions to ensure this new rule is followed. This policy was voted on and is being enforced by the Timberline Figure Skating Board.

Please plan ahead to make sure that you have the proper signature on your test/competition permission form. A standard copy of the form can be found on the Timberline website (www.timberlinefsc.org).

I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the “activity”.

I fully understand that this “activity” involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the “activity”, the conditions in which the “activity” takes place, or the negligence of the “releasees” named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the “activity”.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Timberline Figure Skating Club, United States Figure Skating, it’s directors, officers, administrators, sponsors, volunteers, agents, employees, staff, instructors, trainers, other participants and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the “activity” takes place (each considered one of the “Releasees” herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the “releasees” or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.

The Timberline Figure Skating Club has the right, but not the obligation, to provide rules, regulations and/or ice monitors for Club Ice. We hereby acknowledge that the Timberline Figure Skating Club shall not be responsible for the supervision of the members at Club Ice.

I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

Part 3 - ICE RULES (*TFSC Policies and Procedures (revised May 24, 2004)*)

General

1. Keep the ice rink area and dressing rooms tidy. Pick up all trash.
2. Kleenex is to be discarded or pocketed.
3. No swearing, screaming or displays of temper on the ice or in the locker rooms.
4. No displaying any behaviors that could be described as abusive, vindictive, sexual or violent.
5. Proper respect must be shown to coaches, ice and music monitor as well as other skaters at all times by both the skaters and parents.
6. CD's should be marked with the skaters' name.
7. Do not bring valuables to the rink; the club is not responsible for theft or vandalism.

On Ice

1. Skaters must check in with the rink monitor at the start of every session. If a rink monitor is not present then a coach who is present will act as rink monitor.
2. No gum chewing, eating or spitting on the ice.
3. No talking and standing on the ice in another skaters' way. Please move over to the boards when not skating. If you must stop or visit, please use hockey boxes
4. Only skaters and coaches should be on the ice.
5. Parents and skaters should not interrupt a skater or their coach when they are having a lesson.
6. Dress in appropriate attire for skating.
7. No one is allowed on the ice without skates.
8. The skater who is doing their program music has the right-of-way. The skaters having a lesson have the second right-of-way. Be alert and learn to identify other skaters' music.
9. No sitting on the boards around the ice rink.
10. No glass bottles on the ice or carrying beverages around while skating.
11. No kicking the ice or boards.
12. Exit the ice promptly when the Zamboni comes out. Please remove personal items from the boards.
13. No sitting or lying on the ice unless you are seriously hurt, get up from a fall right away.
14. Low sessions must have a coach present.
15. No skater can be on the ice without a rink monitor or coach present.
16. No horseplay.
17. Music will be handled by the rink monitor, coach or designated individual only.
18. Programs will be played in the order they arrive.
19. There is a 20-minute limit per skater on the jump harness at MarathonPark.
20. Spins are to be done in the middle of the ice and jumps on the ends unless the skaters' program is being skated.

Administrative

1. Ice cannot be purchased in blocks of less than one hour including a 10-minute ice resurface. If a skater wishes to skate for only 15 minutes or 30 minutes they still must pay for one hour of ice.
2. If only a portion of a package is purchased then the skater is required to pay the current walk-on rate.
3. Ice is not transferable to another individual outside of the skater's family member.
4. A coach cannot transfer a session.
5. A coach can approve a skater coming onto a High Session if the session is not filled.

Remember whether you are on the ice, in a locker room or at a competition, you represent the Timberline Figure Skating Club and should do so with respect, dignity and good sportsmanship showed to everyone you encounter.

Members of the board and the professional staff may enforce these rules by having the violator removed from the ice for the remainder of the session. The skater will not receive a refund for the session. Repeated incidents will be discussed with the parent and if the behavior is not corrected, the skater will be asked not to return to the rink.

The undersigned skater understands and agrees to follow all club safety and ice rules as outlined by TFSC policies and procedures.

Safe Sport Statement for Membership Renewal

Timberline Figure Skating Club is committed to creating a safe and positive environment for members' physical, emotional and social development and ensuring that it promotes an environment free of misconduct.

The following code of conduct applies to all participants in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating and Timberline Figure Skating Club including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions, training camps and local rink activities.

I recognize that my participation or my child's in all the activities associated with U.S. Figure Skating and Timberline Figure Skating Club is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents.

U.S. Figure Skating Member Code of Conduct GR 1.02

I recognize that my participation in all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions and training camps, is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents. As a precondition to participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I will adhere to the following tenets in good faith:

A. I will exhibit the highest standards of fairness, ethical behavior and genuine good sportsmanship in all of my relations with others.

B. I will not damage public or private property. I understand that I may be held financially responsible for damage deemed to be wantonly or willfully executed on my part and that I may be subject to disciplinary action by U.S. Figure Skating.

C. I will not use or possess illegal drugs, and I will not engage in criminal activity. I understand that, if I am found to use or possess illegal drugs, or if I am found to engage in any criminal activity during any activity hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I may be subject to criminal penalties as well as penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating.

D. I will adhere to the rules of U.S. Figure Skating and the host organization at all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

E. I will comply with all applicable anti-doping rules including, but not limited to, ISU and USADA anti-doping rules.

F. I will conduct myself in a manner not detrimental to the welfare of figure skating. I understand that my actions reflect on U.S. Figure Skating and the sport of figure skating both positively and negatively. I understand that if my acts, statements, or conduct are considered detrimental to the welfare of figure skating by the appropriate authority, I may be subject to penalties imposed by U.S. Figure Skating pursuant to GR 1.04.

G. I understand that the penalties that may be imposed may include, but are not limited to, loss of future international selections, loss of financial support from U.S. Figure Skating and its Memorial Fund, and loss of participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating.

H. I understand that all disciplinary proceedings will be conducted pursuant to Article XXV, Section 3, of the U.S. Figure Skating bylaws, and that my rights and remedies are derived therefrom.
