This letter contains important instructions regarding the forms that must be turned in by **January 26** and all show details. Please keep these instructions to refer back to, and let us know if you have questions at timberlinefsc@gmail.com.

We hope this will be a fun experience for you and your skater!

Order Forms – if you will be unable to return order forms by the due date let us know right away

- **T-Shirt:** All skaters are required to purchase one long-sleeve t-shirt to wear for the opening number. These shirts are \$17, and available in child & adult sizes (see back for example). Additional long & short-sleeve t-shirts and hoodies are available for purchase also.
- **DVD:** Professionally produced show DVDs are available for pre-order, and make a great keepsake for your skater each year! We will also have order forms available at the show, \$25 each.
- **Mondors:** All skaters will need a pair of over the boot suntan mondor tights in good condition without rips, runs or tears. You are welcome to use a pair in good condition you already have or purchase mondors on your own; however, if you would like us to purchase a pair for your skater we will do a group order. Please refer to chart on order form for size.
- **Program Shout-Out:** This is your opportunity to wish your skater good luck or congratulate them in the show program. The options are text only for \$5, or text & photo for \$10. We ask that you keep text to 65 characters maximum.
- **Silent Auction Basket Donation:** Fundraising for the show helps to keep ice costs down for all of our skaters throughout the year. If you are able, we ask each family either for a donation of a complete basket, basket item, or \$10 donation for the club to purchase items for the baskets. ***This is not mandatory, but is greatly appreciated!***
- **Business Ad:** Timberline will solicit ads for the show program, but if you have a business/know of a business that would like to sponsor our show we'd love to have them! Ad prices & details are on the order form. **Business Ad order form & payment is due February 23**

Costumes – We will notify you when costumes arrive (we anticipate by the end of January, beginning of February), and will hand out at Greenheck on Saturdays and Marathon Park on Mondays. The balance due will need to be paid in full in order for skaters to receive their costumes. Please try on each one to make sure they fit, as we may be able to exchange if given enough time.

Show Pictures – Picture day will be February 23, 2019 at Greenheck Fieldhouse for Snowplow through Pre-Freeskate and February 24 for Freeskate-Advanced and solos. We will be using the upstairs locker rooms, and there will be parent volunteers to help. The schedules are attached; please have your skater ready in costume, tights and skates with

hair/makeup done (at your discretion) at least 10 minutes before your scheduled time. We will do our best to stay on schedule!

Show Practice Schedule

The practice schedule is also attached – we begin practice the week of March 7. Your skater is expected to attend each practice their group is scheduled for as these are group routines, and the groups rely on each member being there to learn the number. If you are unable to attend a practice, let us know as soon as you can!

Opening/closing - For the opening number skaters wear show long sleeve shirt & black bottoms of their choice. For the closing number skaters wear one of the following: 1. The last costume they have on 2. Show shirt & black bottoms 3. Skaters with a solo may wear their solo costume.

Volunteer/List of duties for show – Volunteering is expected of each family in order to make your skater’s show a success! We will be posting volunteer opportunities through Entryeze, and there are many volunteer opportunities available to choose from. We truly appreciate all of your help!

Hair/makeup – Hair should be pulled back and away from the face in a ponytail, bun or braids. Your skater is free to wear their hair however they are comfortable. Makeup is optional depending on your preference.

We could not put on the show without you! We look forward to presenting a great Spring Show!
